SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS:

On April 20, 2010, Charging Party, **Luke P. Patrino**, filed an affidavit with the Ohio Civil Rights Commission alleging that Respondent, **Ohio Vietnam Veteran's Memorial Park Board**, engaged in an unlawful discriminatory practice. Specifically, Charging Party alleged that Respondent denied public accommodation due to his military status and in retaliation for complaining about Respondent's policies. All jurisdictional requirements for filing a charge had been met.


FINDINGS OF FACT:

During the Commission's investigation, it gathered relevant information. Based upon its investigation, the Ohio Civil Rights Commission finds that information and records do not raise an inference that the Charging Party was denied public accommodation due to his military status and in retaliation for complaining about Respondents policies.

DECISION:

Based on the investigation conducted in this matter, the Ohio Civil Rights Commission has determined that there is **NO PROBABLE CAUSE** to believe that the Respondent engaged in an unlawful discriminatory practice under section 4112 of the Ohio Revised Code and hereby orders that this matter be **DISMISSED**.
